Worship Sunday's at 10:00 It was 49 years ago during the Advent, Christmas season that I experienced a fresh infilling of the presence of Christ in my life. I was struggling with my faith, there was little power or relevance in living out my life. I believed he was my savior, my sins were forgiven and I thanked God for that. But is that all there was to my faith, belief my sins were forgiven in the past, what about the presence of Christ in my life that enables and empowers me to live for him to experience a full and abundant life through him. I was living in the past when what I needed was Christ present with me now!

For many I think belief in Christ is mainly living in the past tense. By that I mean they have trusted Christ for salvation stuck in the past when God calls us to live in the present. Tragically too many Christians live in the past tense belief but believing God for little more since then.

I want to ask you a question. Is the scope of your belief in Christ in the past tense security of salvation, or is it a living reality of an active, ongoing lifestyle of believing Christ. In other words are we simply nouns—believers? Or are we also verbs—believing in Christ we are called to be living verbs. We are called to the ONGOING act of believing.

It was during that Christmas season that I realized I was living in the past. And in a time of intense soul searching and the help of Christian friends I came to see that belief was more then just statements of belief but rather allowing Christ to fill my life empowering me to live for him.

Our Noisy Sunday offering on January 30 will be for Simpson Shelter. Simpson Housing Services began as an emergency overnight shelter in the basement of Simpson United Methodist Church in 1982. Since then, it has become a leading nonprofit providing assistance to people experiencing homelessness. It can house 44 men and 22 women, 365 days per year. It is a safe space where their guests can explore stable housing options and resources. Cedar UMC has supported Simpson Shelter for many years through cash donations, meal prep at the shelter and donations of clothing and other household items.
